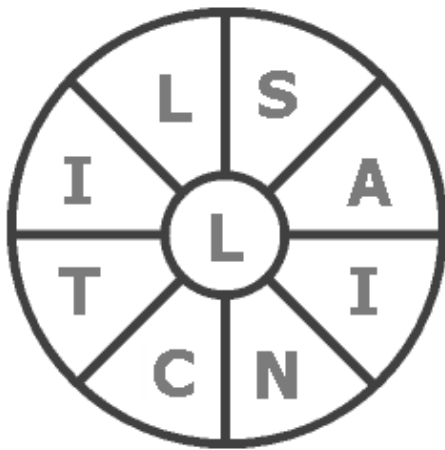

Charity shops, Lewis Manning and Prama will collect donated furniture to sell in their shops provided that furniture coverings have a fire retardant label

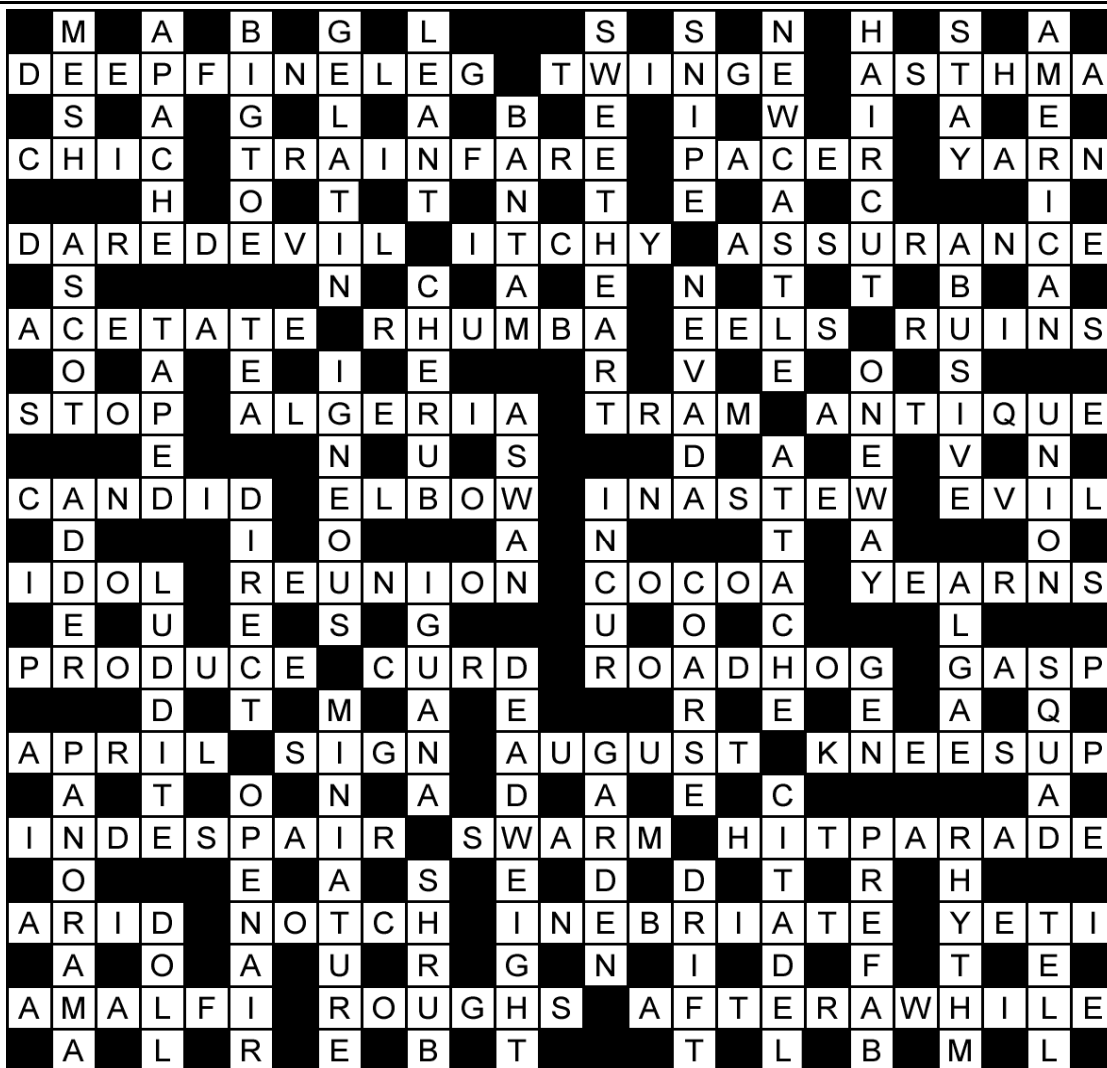
